Students will receive instruction in: The basics of Marine Service and Technology, both theory and repairs including Mercury and other engine brands. Students will achieve an Industry Recognized credential with Mercury Marine Systems Technician Certificate. This will allow you to continue with Mercury University if you decide to work at a Certified Mercury Dealer.

Students will also receive career counseling, mentorship, tutoring hands-on-training and job placement assistance.
