Please be advised that we have received notice concerning the closing of the Alford Street Bridge. **THE BRIDGE WILL BE CLOSED FROM OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> 2018 THROUGH APRIL 1 2019. THE BRIDGE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO OPEN DURING THAT TIME NOR WILL BOATS OF ANY SIZE BE ABLE TO GO UNDER THE BRIDGE.**

*Coast Guard Sector Boston*

*To meet this aggressive schedule the Alford Street Bridge contractor will begin working on **October 1st** and will go 24 X 7 as planned. Unfortunately, to accomplish this work, they will need crane barges in the channel under the bridge spans. If for some reason the crane barge is not needed they will relocate out of the channel, but most of the work that needs to get accomplished on this aggressive time schedule will involve a crane barge in the channel. I cannot over-state this aggressive schedule to be ready for next summer's boating season..*
