



COMMITTEE REPORTS

PORT OPERATOR'S GROUP: P.C. Peter Gilson spoke on the following: **USCG:**

- LCDR Ben Lyons (Waterways) leaves on Friday for a new assignment.
- The Hall-Whittaker bridge will likely be replaced with a temporary structure.
- Sector Boston has a new emergency phone number: 833-449-0539.
- Hurricane season is underway with low pressure areas already forming SE of Puerto Rico.....BE PREPARED !!!!
- The Sumner Tunnel will be closed between July 5th and August 31st. Significant traffic issues are likely.
- The Sea Installer vessel is now scheduled to visit Salem in late July.
- Acquapoluzza is scheduled for July 15th between Noon and 8:00 pm.
- Vessels visiting the July 4th fireworks on the Charles River should be aware that the Creige bridge between will not be opened 11:00 pm and 1:00 am.
- The annual Frogman Swim went well with no issues.
- The CG issued its ruling on the Boston Long Island Replacement Bridge proposal on the 15th of June. The proposed bridge with a 51-foot height and 150-foot width: WILL NOT REASONABLY EFFECT NAVIGATION: A 30 DAY COMMENT PERIOD WILL BE ANNOUNCED after which a final ruling will be announced.
- A total of 16 Port Security Grant proposals were received. Award announcements will be made in late August.

MASSPORT:

- 22 of a projected 154 cruise ships have arrived at Cruiseport Boston to date.
- They will be hosting two Mass Maritime Cadet interns this summer.

MBHSC:

- The Coastal Resiliency Cruise has been scheduled for a later date.
