#### **Report Whales**

Endangered right whales visit our waters year-round. Swimming close to shore, they can be difficult to spot. Stay alert and look out for whales!

If you see a right whale, slow down. Vessels 65 feet or greater in length must travel 10 knots or less in Seasonal Management Areas: www.greateratlantic.fisheries.noaa.gov/shipstrike.

Stay at least 1500 feet (500 yards) away from right whales-it's the law. Be cautious when transiting areas where are whales present.
